

How to make a Snood Face Covering from an old t-shirt

Are you ready to get your crafty side on? Keen to recycle your favourite old t-shirt and learn how to make a face covering ... with loads of enviro-goodness?

Solution? Slice and dice it into a Snood (or buff or neck gaiter depending on what you call these things!).



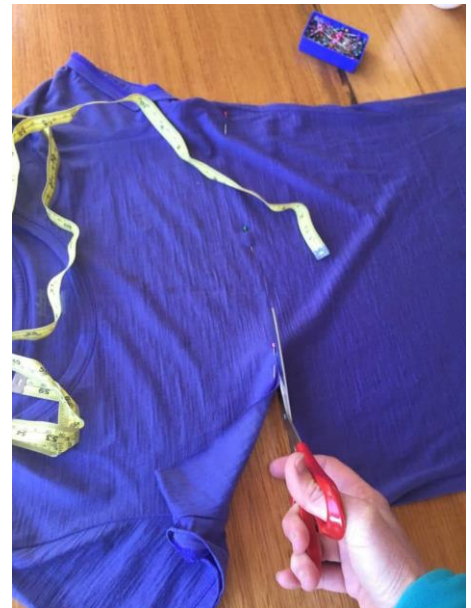
Step 1

Lay t-shirt flat. Measure 41cm (16") from bottom hem towards armpit and mark line with pins.

Step 2:

Cut along 41 cm line.

(If you want a larger neck gaiter that wraps twice around your neck, all you need to do is hem the raw edge and voila!)



Step 3: Cut along side seams

Cut along both sides of the tube and open out flat.



Step 4: Join the side seam

With right sides facing, sew up the side seam with zig zag stitch or an over-locker.

Step 5: Hem top and bottom

Hem the top and bottom of the snood.
